~Stroller Checklist~

Follow these steps to ensure your Stroller meets L'il Angels Consignment Sale's Standards:

Inspect for Damage:

- Check for any visible damage, such as cracks, bends, or sharp edges on the frame. We will not accept any item with signs of rust or possible impending issues.
- Look for loose or missing screws, bolts, or other fasteners.
- Inspect the wheels for wear and tear. Make sure they are securely attached.
- Examine the fabric for tears, fraying, or signs of excessive wear.

Verify Recall Status:

- Check to see if your model has been recalled. You can do this by entering the model and serial number on the manufacturer's website or checking the Consumer Product Safety Commission Site - www.cpsc.gov.
- If there is a Recall on the item that provides a repair to make the item safe, this repair needs to be in place BEFORE the item can be sold at our Sale Event.

Cleanliness:

- Thoroughly clean and wipe down the stroller, including the fabric, frame, and all nooks and crannies.
- Pay special attention to areas where mold or mildew could accumulate, such as folds and creases in the fabric.
- Ensure there are no stains, odors, crumbs or pet hair on the fabric.
- Use gentle, non-toxic cleaning products to avoid any harmful residues that could be transferred to the next child that uses it.

Functionality Check:

- Test the folding mechanism to ensure it operates smoothly and securely locks into place.
- Verify that the brakes engage and disengage properly.
- Check the recline mechanism (if applicable) to ensure it adjusts smoothly and locks securely.
- Test the harness system to ensure it latches securely and releases properly.

Safety Features:

- Ensure that the stroller has a five-point harness system for securing the child. Inspect the harness and straps for any signs of wear and tear. They should not be damaged or frayed.
- All clips and buckles should be in place and function properly.
- Check the canopy or sunshade to protect the child from the sun if applicable to be sure it works properly.
- Verify that there are no exposed moving parts that could pinch little fingers.

Sterilization: Due to the multi-layer fabric covering on strollers, we are required by law in compliance with the ***Bedding and Upholstery Regulation §47.27(b) Secondhand Articles***, to ensure all items of this nature are sterilized prior to placement on our sales floor. This step must be completed at your drop off appointment to our sale. The spray used to sterilize the item is an alcohol based spray. This spray is clear and dries quickly with no lasting odor. Please bring your item to be sanitized to our SPRAY STATION at drop off prior to placing it onto the sales floor.

Please note: Due to the inherent nature of ethyl alcohol (the main ingredient), deep set stains will often resurface when sprayed. This spray does not stain your items, however, it will bring any lingering stain particles to the surface as a natural cleaning reaction. If you do not have your item sterilized at the sale, we will **REJECT** the item from our sales floor as it will be out of **State Licensed Compliance** with our sale event.
